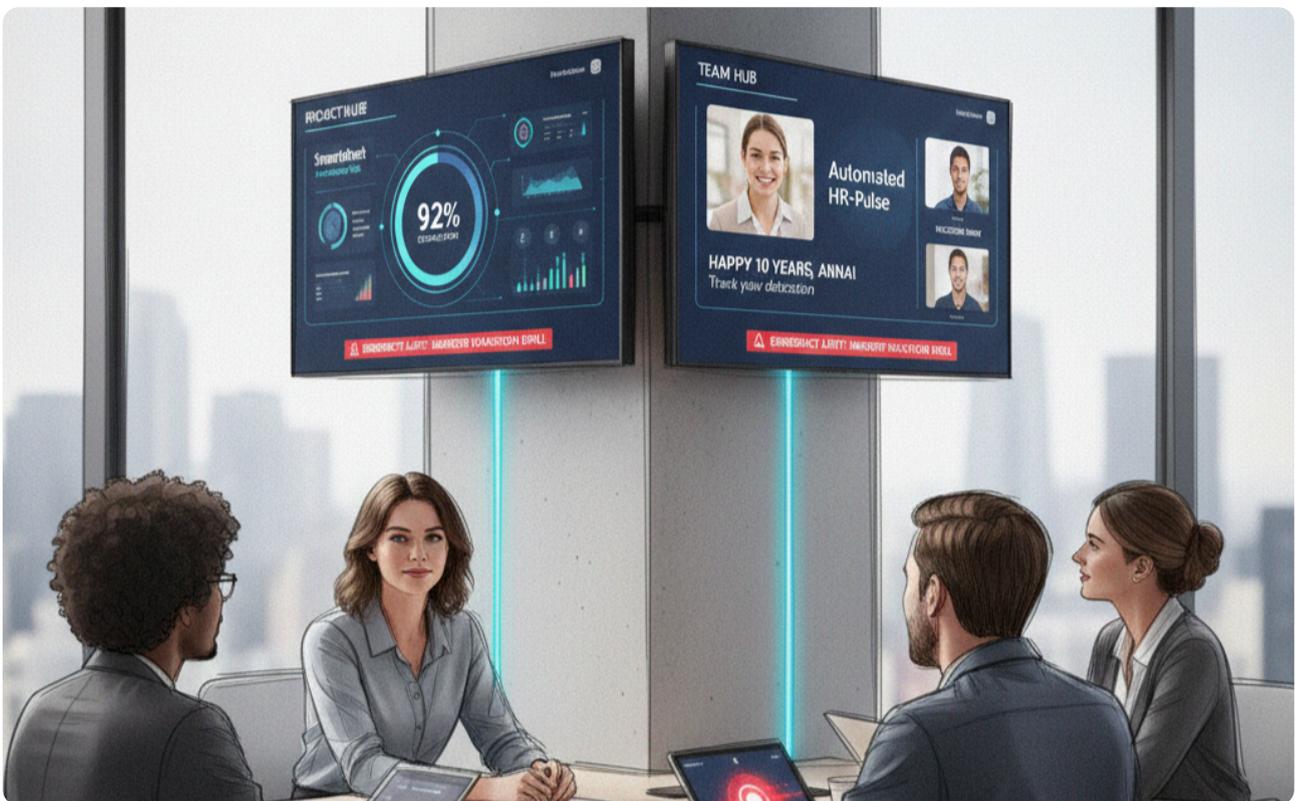

Digital business hubs - How intelligent display strategies drive corporate culture and efficiency

In addition to culture, security plays a key role in modern infrastructure. ScreenWay sees the display network as part of the information and rescue chain. Unified emergency systems enable authorized persons to overwrite all screens at a location with warning messages within seconds in the event of danger. Whether it's a severe weather warning or a fire drill, the technology ensures that the information immediately attracts the attention of employees and that conventional content is immediately superseded. This functionality makes digital signage a safety-relevant investment for the entire site.
