All or individually; controlled from the cell phone

The ScreenWay app sends content to a screen or the entire network. In three steps, without IT knowledge.

Digital signage rarely fails because of the hardware. It fails because of the operation. Content only changes if someone can change it. But then quickly, from anywhere, without a manual. Without IT knowledge.

The ScreenWay app does just that. It controls each screen from your smartphone. Individually or all together.

Three steps.Select content, select screen, send. That's all it takes. No configuration, no training, no technical background. Anyone who can operate a cell phone can also operate ScreenWay.

Individually or all.A display at the counter. A group in the store. Or the entire network across all locations. The app addresses each screen individually or all at the same time, in one action. If you are responsible for twelve stores, you can push a new spot to all counter displays with a single tap.

Find instead of search. Folder navigation, search and preview show what lands on the screen before sending. Programs, media and app instances - everything from a single source, directly on the screen.

Correction where it is noticeable. Most mishaps happen in everyday life: a wrong loop, a forgotten update, a display from yesterday. The error is noticed on site, not on the office PC. The app brings the correction to where the problem is visible. Ten seconds instead of ten minutes.
