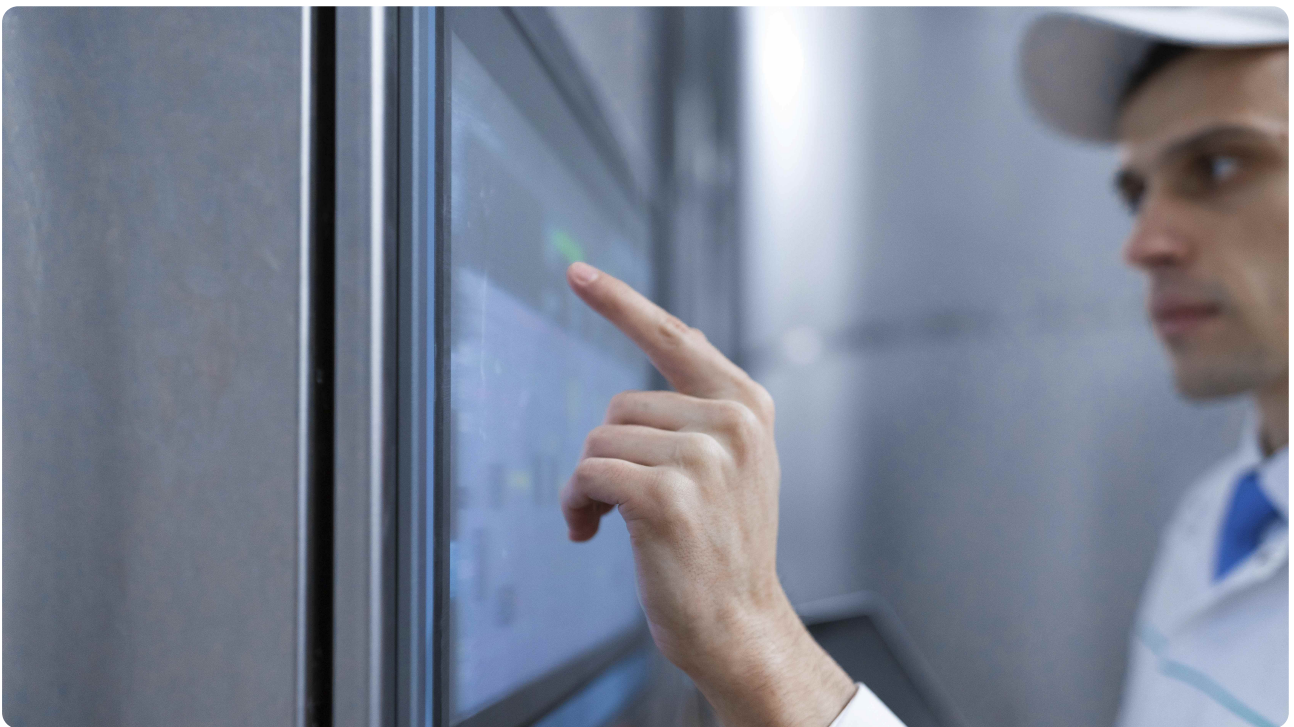

An afternoon until we reach our own terminal

How a team at ScreenWay Studio builds an interactive reception terminal on its own, without HTML and without an agency.

With the Touch Kiosk in ScreenWay Studio, any authorized team member can set up an interactive screen on their own. You create pages, drag elements onto the screen, and link buttons to destinations. In a hotel, this creates a reception terminal that greets guests and shows them the way to the breakfast room. It can be done in a single afternoon, instead of taking weeks with an agency.

Text, images, videos, image galleries, PDF previews, and QR codes can be freely positioned on a page. Each element can respond to touch. A button takes you to the next page, an image opens the gallery, and a QR code links to a website. Color, font, and corner radii are central to the theme. If the team changes its corporate color later, the entire application will update accordingly. Five pre-designed color schemes are available to choose from.

A welcome screen works best when it's tailored to the location and the people standing in front of it. The Touch Kiosk puts this customization in the hands of the people who know best: the team. The editor runs in ScreenWay Studio, right in the browser. This means you can create your own kiosk in an afternoon, instead of spending weeks working with an

agency.
